TOUR ITINERARY SUMMARY

November 8: Arrival in Tel Aviv

Welcome to Tel Aviv! Your Holy Land journey begins with a tour orientation and welcome dinner.

Hotel: Link Hotel, Tel Aviv (D)

November 9: Nazareth and Galilee

The day starts at Nazareth's Church of the Annunciation, offering religious and historical immersion, followed by a brief city exploration. Next, a drive to Capernaum reveals its biblical significance. Lunch near Capernaum allows for relaxation and culinary delights, followed by exploring its historical sites. The day concludes in Tiberias with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.

Hotel: Mt Beatitude Guest House, Galilee (B, D)



November 10: Mt of Beatitudes & Bethlehem

Begin the day at the Mt. of Beatitudes where you'll have time for communion, reading the Sermon on the Mount and reflection. Then drive down the Jordan Valley to Bethlehem where you'll break bread (dinner) with local peacemakers.

Hotel: Nativity Hotel, Bethlehem (B, D)

November 11: Bethlehem

Visit Camp Aida refugee camp and the Noor Women's Center. Next, explore the Church of the Nativity, Shepherd's Field and learn about Bethlehem Bible College efforts in the community Visit Hebron to explore the complex dynamics of this divided city while seeing iconic landmarks. End the day with dinner with a local journalist.

Hotel: Nativity Hotel, Bethlehem (B, D)

November 12: Settlements & Nabi Saleh

Start the day with a visit to Yesha Council, the representative organization for settlements. Then visit Nabi Saleh to discuss local activism and the Palestinian perspective. Hear fromexpert speakers on topics such as water issues, the complexities of settlements, and settler colonialism. End the day with dinner and a meeting with Parents Circle Family Forum, grassroots organization of Palestinian and Israeli families who have lost immediate family members due to the conflict.

Hotel: Nativity Hotel, Bethlehem (B, D)

November 13: Jerusalem

Embark on your dual narrative tour of the Old City of Jerusalem starting at Dung Gate and including a visit to Temple Mount and Al Aqsa mosque. Next visit Silwan, a neighborhood in East Jerusalem that has been at the center of tensions between Israeli settlers and Palestinian residents. Meet with US Embassy officials and then conclude the day with a Jeff Halper tour on zionism and colonialism.

Hotel: Jerusalem (B, D)

November 14: Tel Aviv and Jaffa

Tour Sheikh Jarrah with Just Vision before depart for a Dual Narrative tour of Tel Aviv and Jaffa. Visit the American Colony in Jaffa and Museum at Maine Friendship House. Then hear from a panel of EU, UK, Canadian and Australian Embassy officials before concluding the tour with a closing dinner and reflection.

November 15: Departure or Extension
