Timothy Ewen Costello AO is an Australian Baptist minister who was the Chief Executive Officer and Chief Advocate of World Vision Australia. Costello worked as a lawyer and served as mayor of St Kilda in Victoria. He has authored a number of books on faith and life. A National Trust poll in 2014 elected him one of Australia's 100 national living treasures. Costello received an honorary doctorate from the Australian Catholic University in recognition of "his contributions to religious life and social justice." He was also awarded the Australian Peace Prize in 2008.
