To be the booking manager for the Green Cathedral Chapel and Tiona Chapel

Main Duties & Responsibilities to include, but are not limited to:

Answer enquiries for those wishing to book the Green Cathedral Chapel and the Tiona Chapel for Weddings, Funerals, Baby Blessings, Church Services and Events. Take Bookings and enter into the Acuity Scheduling System.

Send and Receive Hire Agreements and Booking Information.

Schedule Rehearsals and respond to email and phone calls re the site.

Be responsible for arranging the cleaning/set up of the Green Cathedral and/or the Tiona Chapel. In cases where the cleaner is unable to do the cleaning, then do the cleaning of those areas in preparation for bookings.

Liaise with the Cleaner/Set Up person of the Green Cathedral and/or Tiona Chapel and advise of upcoming bookings.

Check when donations have been made and add to client page.

Promote through social media and webpage images of events held at the Green Cathedral or Tiona Chapel.

Liaise with the supervisor on a regular basis and discuss any issues or relevant information needed to be shared.

Make sure clients know the standards required for the hire and use of the Green Cathedral and/or Tiona Chapel.

Qualifications:

Competent, personable phone and computer skills, including data entry and emails. Attention to detail and maintain the continued up to date response to clients, and record of correspondence.

Experience:

The preferred applicant would be experienced in dealing with the public, and willing to work as a team with others. It would be beneficial to have a knowledge of Community of Christ and the story of the Green Cathedral.
